```
readFile('file.json', function(err, data) {  
    if (err){  
        console.error('cannot read file');  
    }  
    else {  
        try {  
            data = JSON.parse(data);  
            console.log(data);  
        }  
        catch(e) {  
            console.error("invalid JSON");  
        }  
    }  
});
```

```
readFile('file.json').then(JSON.parse).then(function(data) {  
    console.log(data);  
})  
.catch(SyntaxError, function(e) {  
    console.error("invalid JSON");  
})  
.catch(function(e) {  
    console.error("cannot read file");  
});
```

```
try {
    var data = JSON.parse(readFile('file.json'));
    console.log(data);
}

// syntax actually not supported in JS but drives the point
catch (SyntaxError e) {
    console.error('invalid JSON');
}
catch (Error e) {
    console.error('cannot read file');
}
```
